NON-SMOKING POLICY ADOPTED



While Vermont law is clear when it comes to smoking in a public place, the Church Council felt it was important to also adopt an official Union Church policy in this regard as follows:

In accordance with Vermont State Law, the UNION CHURCH OF PROCTOR (including all Buildings & Grounds) is a SMOKE-FREE CAMPUS. (Adopted on February 18, 2018)

Those who are on the church campus for any reason and at any time will be expected to adhere to this policy. In addition, the policy (along with our alcohol policy) will be included in future contracts for use (showers, weddings, etc.) of any part of our buildings and grounds.

In this way, we can provide a healthy environment in regard to smoking for all children and adults while they are on church property.
